Contest Rules:

- Contest is open to all currently enrolled High School Seniors in the Tulsa Area.
- One entry per person in each category.
- There are two categories, drawing and photography.
- Drawings can be done in pen and ink, charcoal, pencil, or any mix thereof. Please use fixative or other protective means on any entries that use charcoal or pencil.
- Photographs can be either digital or film. Images may be cropped or trimmed but may not be digitally altered in any way to alter the content.
- All entries should be 16"x20" or smaller, not including any matting or framing.
- All entries must be matted or mounted to cardboard or foam backer board. Framing is optional.
- Entries that are chosen for display will possibly be subject to wind and/or rain. Please keep this in mind when mounting your artwork. TulsaNow will do it's best to care for all entries, but is not liable for any damages that may occur.
- All entries, except the two winners, will be available for pickup during and after the blue dome art festival. Arrangements to be made at a later date.
- All entries should be delivered by May 14th 2007 to TulsaNow, care of the Art & Humanities Council of Tulsa. Harwelden Mansion, 2210 S Main Tulsa, OK 74114 by mail or in person during regular business hours.
